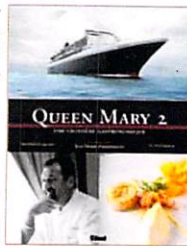
FROM THE NAVIGATOR

QUEEN MARY 2 continued steaming along her North Easterly Great Circle course through the North Atlantic Ocean. Today she will pass over the Maxwell Fracture Zone located in the Mid Atlantic Ocean. Here, depths can shallow out to less than 1,000 metres before deepening again quickly to over 3,500 metres which is approximately 1.9 miles on the opposite side.

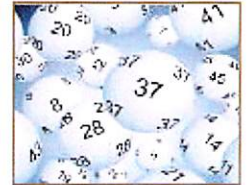

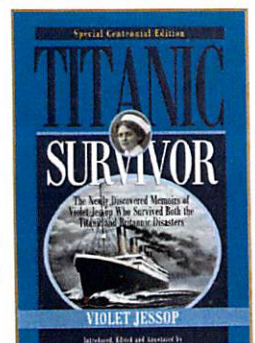
